



## SPMS Performing Arts Workshop Day 2020

It is time to prepare for our Disneyland trip and workshops! This will be a fun and rewarding experience to be able to play, sing, act, dance, and be instructed by the professionals at Disneyland. Please find important information below. Permission slips are attached.

**PERMISSION SLIP AND PAYMENT IS DUE BY WEDNESDAY DECEMBER 18. NO EXCEPTIONS!**

Date/Time: Students need to be at SPMS by 7:00am for a 7:45 departure. We will board the busses from Disneyland at 9:00pm, and depart Disneyland at 9:30pm. Estimated time to return to SPMS is 10:00pm.

Cost: The cost for all students will be \$210. This price includes the workshop fee, a pass to Disneyland and California Adventure, a commemorative gift for each student, and round trip bus transportation. Unfortunately, due to a Disneyland policy, Annual Passes and Cast Member entry tickets will NOT work. Students should also bring money for food or pack food for the day. Several needs based scholarships will be available for each group. Please contact your teacher for more information.

Behavior: Excellent behavior is expected at all times. Students will sign up for groups utilizing a google form and submit phone numbers for all students. *Students must stay with their assigned group all day.* Chaperones will be in the park all day, and teachers will give students a contact number to call or text. There will be a mandatory text check-in at the beginning of the day and a mandatory in person check-in around dinner time in Disneyland at the Jolly Holiday Restaurant.

Chaperones: There is limited space for parent chaperones. If you are interested, please email your student's teacher as soon as possible. Chaperones will be accepted on a first come/ first served basis.

## **SPMS Performing Arts- Disney Workshops**

### 6TH GRADE BAND

Designed for all levels of music students, this unique workshop explores the powerful role music plays in creating the immersive lands and attractions at Disney parks. Through artistic sound analysis, a musical scavenger hunt throughout Disneyland Park and a deeper look into the storytelling power of music, students gain a hands-on understanding of how music can create emotion, atmospheric tone and a vivid sense of time and place. This workshop takes place entirely in Disneyland Park.

### INTERMEDIATE/ADVANCED BAND

Created for students with a musical background, this 90-minute interactive workshop dives even deeper into the world of attraction scoring. Discover how music helps create the immersive experiences at Disney parks. Through the hands-on approach of a music clinic, students meet with a professional musician to explore the various components of music and how it can create atmosphere, emotion and a sense of time and place. The music clinician goes beyond mere theory by encouraging the students to make their own "magic" using elementary instruments—taking the first steps toward becoming interactive composers themselves!

### CHOIR

Intermediate to advanced vocal ensembles experience the excitement of a working recording studio where industry professionals present sight-reading techniques, performance concepts, improvisational tools and the entire process for laying down a musical track. Important performance and rehearsal concepts are reinforced by the supervising Disney clinician. Students have the opportunity to work with a recording technician while using click track and wireless headsets to produce their very own version of a vocal selection from a beloved Disney film. This 90-minute workshop culminates with a screening of the students' recorded work set to Disney film footage!

### DANCE

Led by professional Disney show directors and choreographers, this 90-minute, high-energy workshop gives dancers the opportunity to shine as they learn choreography adapted from a Disney production number exclusively for Disney Performing Arts! Each ensemble receives a valuable critique and learns the importance of the individual's contribution to the overall success of the group. The students' efforts are rewarded with a surprise review of their recorded work. Dance 101 is for all ability levels.

### THEATRE

Designed for all levels of actors, this 90-minute workshop encourages students to develop their acting skills through creative exploration and interpretation. Your Disney teaching artist will focus on tapping into the student's unique voice to develop his/her performance abilities. Students also learn to build confidence, develop improvisational skills and maintain professionalism on the stage.

### ORCHESTRA

Students experience the excitement of a working recording studio where professional clinicians present sight-reading techniques, performance concepts and the entire process of laying down a musical track. Taught by industry composers, arrangers, conductors or studio musicians, this 90-minute workshop culminates with a screening of the students' recorded work set to Disney film footage!
